



VOLUNTEER PROGRAM FAQs

When and where is the conference?

The conference will take on 19-20 March at the Mövenpick Hotel Amsterdam City Centre and Muziekgebouw in Amsterdam. Visit our [website](#) for the full schedule.

How do I apply to be a volunteer?

Complete [this application](#) no later than **22 February, 2019** to be considered for the volunteer program.

What are the requirements of the volunteer program?

You must be a full-time student or an emerging professional to be eligible.

What do I wear to Greenbuild Europe?

Business casual attire is appropriate for the conference. You will be provided with a volunteer shirt to wear during your shift.

Can I attend Greenbuild Europe events and educations before or after my Volunteer shift?

You may attend conference sessions before completing your five (5) hours, as long as they do not conflict with your scheduled volunteer shift times. *If you plan to attend a session before any of your shifts have begun, you will need to collect your conference badge at the Registration Desk.*

What if I do not complete my full five (5) hours of volunteer service but still attend Greenbuild Europe?

You will be charged the price of a 2-day conference pass.

What day and time is my shift?

In the next follow up email, we will provide you with details on your shift time and date. You must arrive 15 minutes prior to your shift. Please remember, the benefits you receive are in exchange for 5 hours of volunteering.

What are my benefits?

(1) Free *Full* Conference Pass, which includes access to Plenary Sessions, Conference Education Sessions, Greenbuild Celebration, Credentials, Program Guide, Lunch, and Volunteer T-Shirt

When is the Greenbuild Celebration?

Tuesday, 19 March, 2019 from 18:00 -20:00.

Can I attend the Women in Green Power Luncheon?

The Women in Green Power Luncheon is not included in the full conference pass. If you choose to attend, there will be an additional fee required. The cost for the luncheon is €50 if you register before 18 February and €75 if you register after 18 February. Additionally, before you register to attend Women in Green, you must ensure that the luncheon does not conflict with your volunteer shift times.
